Certificate of Proficiency in Criminal Investigation**

The Certificate of Proficiency in Criminal Investigation (CP-CI) is for the individual seeking to develop a foundation in criminal justice investigative techniques. Emphasis is on basic investigation principles and practices needed for success in criminal justice professions. The Certificate of Proficiency in Criminal Investigation is a 9-credit hour program designed to be completed in as little as one semester.

In addition to the CP-CI, UA-EACC offers the Technical Certificate in Legal Studies (TC-LS), and the Associate of Science in Criminal Justice (AS-CJ). UA-EACC also provides students the opportunity to earn a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (BS-CJ) through partnerships with universities across the state of Arkansas.
