Certificate of Proficiency in Juvenile Justice**

The Certificate of Proficiency in Juvenile Justice (CP-JJ) is for the individual seeking to develop a foundation in criminal justice professions that works with juveniles. Emphasis is on basic law principles and practices needed for success in criminal justice professions. The Certificate of Proficiency in Juvenile Justice is a 9-credit hour program designed to be completed in as little as one semester.

In addition to the CP-JJ, UA-EACC offers the Technical Certificate in Criminal Justice (TC-CJ), and the Associate of Applied Science in Criminal Justice (AAS-CJ). UA-EACC also provides students the opportunity to earn a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (BS-CJ) through partnerships with universities across the state of Arkansas.
