



Part Time EMS Instructor

Job Description

Position Summary:

The EMT/Paramedic Instructor is responsible for the assistance preparing and implementing teaching and evaluation strategies for EMS students in the classroom as well as in clinical settings.

Responsibilities:

- Must be able to teach didactic and clinical components of EMT and/or Paramedic;
- Participate in the development, planning, implementation, and evaluation of EMS curriculum;
- Participate in scheduled Paramedic Advisory Board meetings;
- Maintain professional standards of practice in teaching in classroom and clinical settings;
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Possess AR EMS Instructor License at EMT Level (Paramedic is preferred).
- Possess a Technical Certificate in Paramedic (Associate's or Bachelor's is preferred).
- Possess an active AR NREMT license.
- Must hold licensure for 2 years to instructor Paramedic.
- Must be willing, if not already in possession, to acquire BLS and ACLS Instructor credentials.

Hourly Wages:

- Maximum of 19 hours per week.
